3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

4. PLANNING

- 7 Pyle Rd Roof extension and patio doors. No objections.
- 39 Pwll Du Lane Single-story extension. No objections.
- 151 Bishopston Road Non-material amendment to Planning Permission Change from concrete tile to fiber cement slate. No objections.

5. ACCOUNTS FOR APPROVAL - December 2024

Reviewed and approved, with no further actions required.

6. 2025-2026 Precept:

- Increase from £107,000 to £108,000.
- £1,000 contingency added for legal fees.
- Unanimous approval of the precept increase
- New furniture, removal of dead trees,

7. Emergency Committee

 Chair advised adding a discussion on forming an "Emergency Committee" to the agenda of the next meeting for further consideration when J Jones is present.

8. Biodiversity & Glyphosate Use Discussion

- K Laurence raised concerns about glyphosate's environmental and health impact.
- Cllr Lyndon Jones cautioned against a full ban without alternative solution and suggested consulting Swansea Council on safety and weed control.

ACTIONS:

- Cllr Lyndon Jones to contact Swansea Council for guidance on glyphosate alternatives.
- Council to review Swansea Council's feedback before taking action.
- Council to consider other community councils sharing practices.

7. PROJECT UPDATES:

ACTIVE TRAVEL TRACK

- Awaiting the Charter Surveyor to meet with Edward Harris on 17/02/25 for an update.
- Cllr Lyndon has been advised that the earliest completion: Summer or Autumn 2025 (pending planning approvals).

WELLFIELD / MURTON PARK

- Equipment ordered & funding secured for Wellfield.
- Expected completion: Spring 2025.

New additions include:

- Wheelchair-accessible roundabout.
- Basketball hoop
- Climbing frame for toddlers..
- Surfacing improvements around play equipment
- Murton Park needs attention; funding will need to be sourced and possible relocating of it due to the covenant.

COPLEY WOODS (INCLUDING PUMP TRACK)

- Swansea Council will handle planning & environmental reports.
- £80,000 in funding secured, but £24,000 still needed.
- Awaiting a meeting with CurveStudios.
- Plans to integrate the project into broader Copley Woods redevelopment, including nature trails.

8. FOOTPATH OFFICER UPDATE: WALKERS ARE WELCOME

1. Trade Show

Bishopston and Pennard WaW had a stall at the Walking Trade Show at The View, Rhossili. Organised by the Swansea and Gower Walking Forum, it was a huge success. Sixteen organisations attended, improving collaboration. The National Trust plans to organise walks in our area, led by our WaW team.

2. Health Walks

We are now actively involved in Health Walks at Pennard, benefiting both villages.

3. Meeting with Valeways

Met with Valeways on 27 January 2025 to discuss maintaining footpaths with volunteers, supporting the Adopt a Path pilot scheme.

4. Storm Damage – Bishopston Valley

The Council's Countryside Access Team has a plan to resolve the storm damage and is seeking funding.

5. Bishopston Valley Improvements

On 18 February, we'll walk Bishopston Valley with the Gower Society and the National Trust to assess further work

6. Knapp Farm to Pwlldu Path

Clearing and widening were done by the Ramblers and Access Team in December/January. Walkers' feedback has been very positive.

7. Adopt a Path Pilot

Delays due to county council responses. Volunteers are frustrated, but I'm addressing this. Discussions have started with SGRC to adopt the Knapp Farm path.

8. Coast Path Rerouting

For information: The rerouting of the coast path from Bracelet to Rotherslade will be completed by the end of March 2025.

9. CITY COUNCIL UPDATE - CLLR LYNDON JONES

- Local Development Plan (LDP2)
- Five landowners in Bishopston submitted sites for LDP2 consideration.
- Three sites moved to Stage 2 for further review (SEE MAPS ATTACHED):
 - Land behind Bishopston Road (51B) Evaluated for residential use.
 - Land east of Long Acre Near bungalows; wildlife records being monitored.
 - Land west of Old Way Adjacent to Eastlands Park; similar objections as Providence Lane.
- Public consultation will be held for residents to submit feedback.

Actions:

- Clerk to post LDP2 updates on Facebook to inform residents.
- Council to encourage residents to submit feedback during consultation.

10. CORRESPONDENCE/CLERK'S REPORT

Water Drainage & Flooding Concerns

- Recent large surface water the community hall car park raised concerns with residents
- Temporary trench suggested to redirect water to the bridge quote being received in due course.
- Active Travel Track should fix this issue when installed.

Actions:


- Clerk and I Shemilt to explore temporary trenching options.


